The Kakatiya Heritage Trust have further mentioned that the Trust aims to fill in the areas where Government and other agencies do not have the resources or capacities and requested that a Steering Committee of stake-holders of Kakatiya Heritage Preservation may be established to co-ordinate these activities till 2013.
